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## Devon County ASA Sprint Meet: Etiquette

- Listen to what the team managers say. Do not wonder off without letting someone know where you are going.
- Make sure you have plenty to eat and drink. Its going to be a long day. If you're not sure what to take have a look at the Welcome Pack in the Competitive and Development section of the Club's website. There's a bit about nutrition in there.
- It is likely that apart from the backstroke all starts will be "over the top". So, when you finish your race hold onto the lane ropes in your lane. DO NOT hang onto the timing boards; this could affect the times for the next swimmer.
- When told to; leave the water by the sides. DO NOT climb out over the timing pads.
- Swim under the lane ropes; swimming over them causes them to stretch.
- Please note that there will be an official watching on every lane on every turn so match sure that you turn correctly and finish correctly.
- Enjoy yourselves! And swim well!
